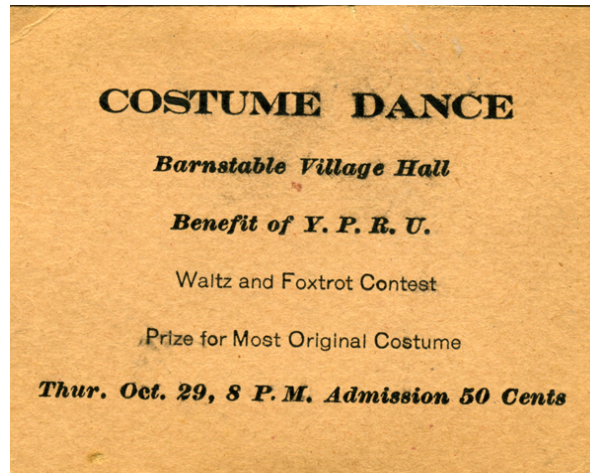

Historical Note: The Village Hall was built in 1912 as a community hall. By 1927 the hall was taken over by the Barnstable Women's Club who raised the funds to pay off the mortgage and renovate the premises. By 1928 the hall was renovated with the additions of a club room, kitchenette, coat rooms, toilets and new entrances. Currently it is the home of the Barnstable Comedy Club.

Scope and Content Note: This collection consists of memorabilia for the hall which includes a historical pamphlet, programs, old tickets and a stock certificate issued in 1911.
